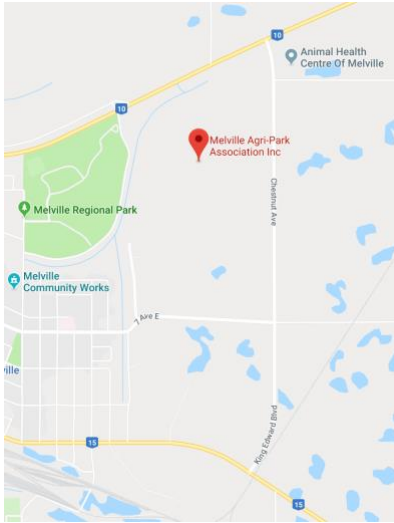

Rule Reminders

- Competitors arriving on the show grounds must report to the show office to verify membership cards, confirm that all is in order with your entry forms and classes, pay any fees owing, and pick up your show numbers. For security reasons, we need to know which horses are on the grounds and ensure that we have the correct contact information.
- There will be zero tolerance for abuse of horses, show officials, or fellow competitors.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times and are not permitted in the warm-up ring or hitching area.
- Late entries day of show will only be allowed for rail classes already scheduled to run. Late entries and class changes day of show will not be allowed in any pattern/test classes.
- **Nobody will participate in the show unless entries are paid in full.**
- All horses entered in the Sport Horse show must be stalled and there is a limit of one horse per stall. It is prohibited to tie a horse to a trailer unless entering the SHF Heritage and Working Western show only.
- Move in time no earlier than 12:00pm Friday July 16th.
- All competitors must be ready in the hitching ring at their ride time; failure to do so may result in automatic scratching of the class. If the show is running early, you are not required to enter the ring prior to your posted ride time but may choose to do so.
- In the event of changes to the schedule, day sheets will be posted daily in the morning of competition. These sheets will inform all competitors of the most current and correct order of go and will override previous scheduling. It is the competitor's responsibility to check for any possible changes.
- **No riders will be allowed to warm-up in or around the competition ring without purchasing a warm-up block of time.**
- Use of shared warm up area is free of charge for all competitors at all times.
- Horses may be schooled only in the designated areas and may only be done by EC Sport License holders.
- Lunging is not permitted in any area where horses are being ridden (see EC Dressage Rules E 7.16).
- Show numbers must be visible on horse or rider/handler during warm-up and any time horse is out of its stall.
- **All Dressage riders (english and western) must wear protective headgear:** All athletes, regardless of age or level of competition, must wear properly fitted and fastened safety approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location. (See Glossary – Headgear Standards; see Article E 4.0; See article A905 General Rules EC).
- **All Junior riders must wear protective headgear:** All juniors will wear properly fitted and fastened approved headgear at all times while riding or driving at the event location. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete in the Heritage classes at these competitions.
- By the breed exemption Rule – B1306.7, adult riders competing in AHA Working Western events may wear a western hat instead of helmet; however, use of helmets is strongly encouraged.
- Any competitor may wear approved protective headgear and/or a protective safety vest, specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the judge.
- All Dressage classes will use Equestrian Canada tests; All AHA Western Dressage classes will use Western Dressage Association of America (WDAA) tests, and all SHF Heritage Western Dressage classes will use Western Style Dressage Association of Canada (WSDAC) tests.
- All horses brought onto show grounds must be entered in at least one class.
- Numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the warm-up, schooling and/or exercise areas as well as in the competition rings, whether the horse is under saddle or not. (Article E 7.11.2 and E 7.11.3). Any Exhibitor using the wrong number or having no number *may* be excused or disqualified from the class at the discretion of the Judge.
- Obvious sideline coaching or obvious ringside assistance while rider is being judged may result in the disqualification of the exhibitor. (SHF#18)
- No person other than the officials, steward, attendants on duty, and the judge of the class may enter the show ring without permission of the judge.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

Per current provincial guidelines, masks are not required at any time during the show. Complimentary masks and sanitizer will be provided should competitors choose to use these precautions. Please continue to use common sense and respect the personal space of others throughout the show.

HEAT PRECAUTIONS

We recognize that there is the potential for extreme heat conditions this weekend. Please note that stabling is outdoors (shaded) and be prepared for this heat. To accommodate the heat, our show committee recommends the following:

- Travel early in the morning or late in the evening; you may arrive on the grounds at any time (please check in at show office as soon as possible)
- The show will start at 7:00 AM and end by 12:00 PM each day to avoid riding during the hottest part of the day (per EC recommendations)
- Ensure you and your horse stay hydrated (water for horses available on grounds, water also sold at canteen)
- Take regular 'cool down breaks' such as within an air conditioned vehicle or in the show office
- Wash bay available

Emergency Procedure / Disaster Plan

1. Do Not Move the Patient.
2. Notify the Show office by telephone or radio, who will then notify medical personnel and Show Staff.
3. Medical personnel will evaluate patient and determine status.
4. Catch the horse (if applicable)
5. Advise the show office by Radio - Show office will call 911. Exhibitors are asked NOT to use their cell phones as the area code affects the directions.
6. Announcer will ask exhibitors to clear the area then Ringmaster, Steward or Show Management will help keep spectators back.
7. Show Personnel will keep the road clear so ambulance can get through without hurting anyone else.
8. A member of Show Personnel should be at front entrance to meet the ambulance Ask them to turn off their siren and escort them to the scene of the accident. (Ambulance sirens could spook a horse and cause additional accidents)
9. Accident forms will be completed by the Show Steward from Equestrian Canada.

Horses and riders will accumulate PAWWSHA Points for each class that they enter **up to a maximum of 8 classes over the weekend**. Points are calculated as follows:
